

SAMUEL GIDDY began organ lessons with Philip Swanton in 2011 after studying piano with Israeli pianist Arnan Wiesel. He gained his Licentiate in organ with distinction at age fifteen. Two years later he commenced at the Sydney Conservatorium, majoring in organ performance and graduating in 2019.

During this time, he served at St Mark's, Darling Point, at St Paul's, Burwood, and in his current role at St Andrew's Cathedral. In 2019 he undertook a recital tour of England, and was also a finalist in the Silbermann Competition in Freiberg, Germany.

Alongside his musical schedule of performing, teaching, and liturgical playing, Samuel is currently undertaking a ministry traineeship at St Barnabas' Anglican Church, Broadway.
