JAMES GOLDRICK ORGAN

Born in Manchester in 1987, James Goldrick received a Bachelor of Music (Organ) from the Newcastle Conservatorium of Music, studying with Philip Matthias. While studying he was Organ Scholar of Christ Church Cathedral, Newcastle, and Acting Conductor of The University of Newcastle Chamber Choir. On returning to Sydney, James commenced at St Mary's Cathedral as Postgraduate Organ Scholar, and was later appointed Assistant Organist, accompanying and conducting the cathedral's daily schedule of Vespers and Mass, as well as playing for large-scale liturgies, including the Dedication and Papal Blessing of Domus Australia in Rome by Pope Benedict XVI. During this time, he completed the Graduate Diploma in Education at the Australian Catholic University. James is currently Assistant Director of Music of St. Stephen's Cathedral, Brisbane, where he is responsible for the training of the boys-and-men Cathedral Choir and the eight-voice Schola, one of Australia's few fully professional choirs. He is a notable exponent of the art of improvisation at the organ. He is also Director of Music of St John's College, University of Queensland.
